

Privacy Statement

Delta Metrics respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the personal information you share with us. This statement describes how Delta Metrics collects and uses your personal information to provide services that you request or when you choose to provide us with your personal information.

Information Collection

Personal information means any information that may be used to identify an individual, including, but not limited to, a first and last name, email address, a postal or other physical address, other contact information, title, occupation, industry, personal interests, and other information when needed to provide a service or product or carry out a transaction you have requested.

When you browse our website, you do so anonymously, unless you have previously registered with us. We do not automatically collect personal information, including your email address. We do log your IP address (the Internet address of your computer) to give us an idea of which part of our website you visit and how long you spend there. But we do not link your IP address to any personal information unless you have registered with us. Like many other commercial websites, the Delta Metrics website may use a standard technologies, such as "cookies" and other HTML tools, to collect information about how you use the site or to record that you opened an email marketing message. Notice

When personal information is collected, we will inform you at the point of collection the purpose for the collection. Delta Metrics will not transfer your personal information to third parties without your consent, except under the limited conditions described under the discussion entitled "Information Sharing and Disclosure" below.

In most cases we will provide you with the opportunity to "opt in" prior to receiving direct marketing or market research information. This means we will require your affirmative action to indicate your consent before we use your information for purposes other than the purpose for which it was submitted. At a minimum, we will always give you the opportunity to "opt out" of receiving such materials. This means we assume you have given us your consent to collect and use your information in accordance with this Privacy Statement unless you take affirmative action to indicate that you do not consent, for instance by sending Delta Metrics an e-mail at info@Delta-Metrics.com instructing us you would like to "opt out" of any further e-mails or phone calls.

Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies

A cookie is a small data file that certain websites write to your computers hard drive when you visit them. A cookie file can contain information such as a user ID that the site uses to track the pages you have visited, but the only personal information a cookie can contain is information

you supply yourself. A cookie cannot read data off your hard disk or read cookie files created by other sites. Some parts of Delta Metrics's website use cookies to track user traffic patterns. We do this in order to determine the usefulness of our website information to our users and to see how effective our navigational structure is in helping users reach that information.

If you prefer not to receive cookies while browsing our website or via HTML-formatted emails, you can set your browser to warn you before accepting cookies and refuse the cookie when your browser alerts you to its presence. You can also refuse all cookies by turning them off in your browser, although you may not be able to take full advantage of Delta Metrics's website if you do so. In particular, you may be required to accept cookies in order to complete certain actions on our website. You do not need to have cookies turned on, however, to use/navigate through many parts of our website, except access to certain of Delta Metrics's web pages may require a login and password.

How We Use Information Collected

Delta Metrics uses information for several general purposes: to fulfill your requests for certain products and services, to personalize your experience on our website, to keep you up to date on the latest product announcements, software updates, special offers or other information we think you would like to hear about either from us or from our business partners, and to better understand your needs and provide you with better services. We may also use your information to send you, or to have our business partners send you, direct marketing information or contact you for market research.

Information Sharing and Disclosure

Because Delta Metrics is part of tecsis Corporation, a global company, your personal information may be shared with other tecsis Corporation offices or subsidiaries around the world. All such entities are governed by this Privacy Statement or are bound by appropriate confidentiality and data transfer agreements.

Your personal information is never shared outside Delta Metrics without your permission, except under conditions explained below. Your information may be stored and processed in the United States or any other country where Delta Metrics, its subsidiaries, affiliates or agents are located.

Delta Metrics may send your personal information to other companies or people under any of the following circumstances:

- When we have your consent to share the information;
- If sharing your information is necessary to provide a product or service you have requested (If your information is shared with third parties we will only provide the information they need to deliver the service. Also, such companies are prohibited from using your information for any other purpose);
- As part of a joint sales promotion or to pass sales leads to one of our distribution partners; and

- To keep you up to date on the latest product announcements, software updates, special offers or other information we think you would like to hear about either from us or from our business partners (unless you have opted out of these types of communications).

We will also disclose your personal information if required to do so by law, or in urgent circumstances to protect personal safety, the public or our website.

Data Security

Your Delta Metrics account information is password-protected for your privacy and security. Delta Metrics safeguards the security of the data you send us with physical, electronic, and managerial procedures. While we strive to protect your personal information, we cannot ensure the security of the information you transmit to us, and so we urge you to take every precaution to protect your personal data when you are on the Internet. Change your passwords often, use a combination of letters and numbers, and make sure you use a secure browser.

Children and Privacy

Our websites do not target and are not intended to attract children under the age of 18. Delta Metrics does not knowingly solicit personal information from children under the age of 18 or send them requests for personal information.

Third Party Sites
